8. Competitors will be required to stock judge four animals and the competition will run under the YFC rules requiring the animals to be placed A, B, X and Y. (The Beef Challenge cattle will be judged as Commercial Beef not Breeding animals).
9. In the event of two competitors being equal on points, the points awarded in the Stock Judging element will be used to determine the winner.
