

Entries Pouring in for Britain's Biggest Cider Championships the British Cider Championships

Entries have been pouring in for Britain's biggest and best cider competition the British Cider Championships - which will be staged in the Orchards and Cider Exhibition at the Royal Bath and West Show, May 1-4 June.

Last year's competition attracted over 650 entries, predominantly from the West Country, but with all the main cider-making regions of Britain strongly represented, and with the renaissance in artisan ciders, both traditional and modern, continuing, the organisers are expecting even more this time.

"The Championships in their third year and are going from strength to strength and is already becoming the blue riband event for both craft and commercial cider-makers", says Anthony Gibson, Orchards and Cider Chairman.

"We welcome all entries, whether they are from the smallest artisan cider maker, or the largest commercial producers, and if anyone hasn't entered yet but is thinking about it, there is still time entries close 17 April.
