Tuesday	12:00noon to 7:00pm	All stock
Wednesday	8:00am to 8:00pm	All Stock incl Dairy Calves and Trade Stands
<b>Departure of Animals</b>		Animals may be loaded: From 4:00pm Saturday
<b>Stock Gate</b>		Will be closed between 8:30am and 7:00pm each day.
<b>Accommodation</b>		<p>Accommodation is very limited and can only be booked when making entries.</p> <p>Twin bedded rooms in the cattle buildings are available for CATTLE exhibitors in the first instance. After the entry close date for Dairy Cattle any available rooms may be offered to other stock exhibitors.</p> <p>Beds or rooms are booked for the period of show. Those booking an individual bed WILL share a room.</p>
<b>Exhibitor Camping</b>		<p>Caravans, motorhomes, tents, trailers etc used by Stock Exhibitors staying on site during the Show, must be located in the Stock Exhibitors' Camping Park for Emergency Services reasons.</p> <p>No electricity is provided but the use of silent diesel generators is permitted from 9:00am to 5:00pm.</p>
<b>Stalling &amp; Penning</b>		The Show will allocate stalls and pens after entries close and reserves the right to amend as necessary.
<b>Dairy</b>		<p>Senior Cow – 2 x stalls</p> <p>Calves &amp; Heifers – 1 x stall</p>
<b>Payment of Prizes (Reg 59)</b>		Winning exhibitors will be issued with a prize money voucher which must be redeemed during the show. Vouchers not presented will be forfeited. Championship prize money will be paid after the show.

**Smoking (Reg 10)**  
**Smoking (including E-cigarettes) is not allowed in any of the livestock buildings, sheep lines, dairy, parlour or any indoor areas. Owners of animals being exhibited will be held responsible for the behaviour of their stockpersons and for the consequences of any misconduct.**

**Competence of Exhibitors (Reg 21)**  
All Exhibitors must have the physical ability and experience and be competent to handle animals in their charge.

**Removal of Animals (Reg 42)**  
No animal shall be removed from its place in the show except at the times stated in the schedule.

**Veterinary Examinations (Reg 45)**  
The decision of the Veterinary Officer shall be final and conclusive. Exhibitors shall be liable to pay for drugs administered by the Veterinary Officers.

**Dairy**  
**Ringworm** – animals exhibiting any signs at any stage will be disqualified and removed from the Show. (Reg 49)  
**Malpractices** – No artificial contrivance or device of any description to be used preventing the flow of milk. (Reg 75).

<b>Camping</b>	<p>For all exhibitors staying on the showground other than in Stock Exhibitor Rooms. £10.00 per vehicle pass</p> <p>Does not admit the driver who must hold a day ticket or wristband.</p> <p>Tickets/wristbands will be required from Tuesday 12noon (start of Stock Reception).</p> <p>Caravans etc can be delivered to the showground prior to the Show from Monday. Arrivals before this date will be refused entry. Access to the showground will be via the Main Gate and a valid Stock Exhibitor Camping pass will be required. The property of the same exhibitor but not necessarily exhibitor bred. The animals to be selected from the entries in the above classes and no exhibitor may enter more than one group in this class. The winning group to go forward to the Dairy Group Interbreed Championship (Clare Trophy C10).

**Class C123 PAIR OF ANIMALS**
