Over 1,200 Key Stage 2 pupils will descend on the Bath & West Showground, for the Society's 5th Annual Field to Food Learning Day. It will be a day packed full of interactive activities and demonstrations, educating children all about the process of field to fork, giving them the opportunity to look, hear, smell and get their hands dirty – one of the most effective (and fun) ways to learn!
