On the final day of the show The Great British Kitchen will have a Caribbean feel when Wilfred Emmanuel-Jones MBE, 'The Black Farmer', comes to Somerset.

Following visitor feedback, the organisers are also excited to be introducing a brand-new Cheese Marquee as well as the Regional Food & Drink Marquee.
