BPA PIG OF THE YEAR AWARD

These awards are promoted through The British Pig Association. All animals entered in this Competition must be the property of a Member of the British Pig Association or the British Lop Society and must be registered in a herd book of the BPA or the British Lop Pig Society. The eligible breeds are:

Berkshire, British Lop, British Saddleback, Duroc, Gloucestershire Old Spots, Hampshire, Landrace, Large Black, Large White, Middle White, Oxford Sandy & Black, Pietrain, Tamworth and Welsh.

To be eligible for a qualifying round a pig (male or female) must be born on or after 1 July of the year previous to the show.

A pig judged Best Male (Modern or Traditional) or Best Female (Modern or Traditional) in a qualifying round cannot compete in any subsequent round. If a pig having qualified at an earlier show again qualifies at a later show the judge for that breed shall select an alternative pig of the same breed and sex from any class covering the required age group.

Where a single breed has more than one class covering the required age group for either sex so permitting more than one first prize winning animal, the Judge will nominate one for the qualifying round.

Where there are multi-breed classes, ie Any Other Modern/Any Other Traditional, the judge must nominate the best male and best female of the qualifying age of each breed represented (regardless of class prizes). These pigs will compete in the qualifying round with eligible entries from individual breed classes.

Prizes:

All animals entered in this Competition must be the property of a Member of the British Pig Association or the British Lop Society and must be litter notified and registered in a herd book of the BPA or the British Lop Pig Society. The eligible breeds are:

Berkshire, British Lop, British Saddleback, Duroc, Gloucestershire Old Spots, Hampshire, Landrace, Large Black, Large White, Middle White, Oxford Sandy & Black, Pietrain, Tamworth and Welsh.

A pig judged Best Young Male or Best Young Female in a qualifying round cannot compete in any subsequent round. If a pig having qualified at an earlier show again qualifies at a later show the judge for that breed shall select an alternative pig of the same breed and sex from any class covering the required age group.

Where a single breed has more than one class covering the required age group for either sex, so permitting more than one first prize winning animal, the Judge will nominate one for the qualifying round.

Where there are multi-breed classes, ie Any Other Modern/Any Other Traditional breed the judge must nominate the best male and best female of the qualifying age of each breed represented (regardless of class prizes). These pigs will compete in the qualifying round with eligible entries from individual breed classes.

Glass trophy for the Best Young Pig of each sex. Rosettes only will be presented at each preliminary round. Glass Trophies for the preliminary rounds will be presented at the final.
