How much are tickets for the Show?

Advance Ticket (19 December 2023 – 17 May 2024)

To help us manage the flow of traffic more effectively during the Show, we are introducing day specific tickets. Any day tickets are still available to purchase if you are unsure which day you wish to attend.

Day Specific | ± 25 – Adult only or ± 26 Adult + Child **Any Day** | ± 28 – Adult only

Can I purchase tickets on the day?

Tickets can be purchased on the day, however there are some great savings to be made when booking in advance.



What age range is a child?

Children are aged between 5 – 15 years.

My child is under 5 years old – do I have to pay for them?

Children under the age of five are FREE

Can I camp at the Show?

Camping is available to purchase on our website (bathandwest.com/tickets).

Pitches are £30 per night for a Grass, Non-Electric Pitch.

You will also need to purchase a ticket to gain access to the Show.

Do you provide free tickets to carers?

To ensure that everyone can access the Royal Bath & West Show and have an enjoyable experience, we are pleased to operate an *Essential Companion Scheme*. This is offered to those who need somebody to be present in order to assist them to readily access the Royal Bath & West Show and its services through the means of mobility and guidance.

Can I hire a mobility scooter at the Show?

Where is the disabled parking located at the Show?

The disabled parking is located at the front of our Yellow Car Park. Please follow the AA Road Signs. Don't forget to present your blue badge on arrival and one of the Car Parking Stewards will direct you to the disabled parking area.

How much is parking?

Parking is FREE

Do you have baby changing facilities?

Yes, we have baby changing facilities located in each toilet block. We also have baby changing facilities in the outdoor RED Accessible Toilet Block (Orchard) and in the Showering Pavilion Accessible Toilet Block.

Can I fly my drone at your event?

Due to the number of people and livestock at our event the flying of drones from or over the Royal Bath & West Show is strictly prohibited.

Will there be a Family Trail this year?

Yes, the Family Trail will return this year. You can collect your Family Trail at the entrance gates of the Show. Once you have completed the trail, don't forget to complete your details on the back and post it as you leave for your chance to win an exciting prize!

Can I bring my dog to the Show?

Yes, dogs are welcome to come along to the Show, but we do kindly ask that they are always kept on a lead. There are a handful of areas where dogs are not permitted. These areas include: The Main Lawn, the Food & Drink Marquee, the Horticulture Tent, the Cheese Marquee & within any Livestock Buildings / Marquees.
