When is the Royal Bath & West Show?

2 – 4 June 2022

This is during half term and falls on the Queen's Jubilee Bank Holiday Weekend

What are the opening hours for the Show?

Thursday | 9am – 6pm

Friday | 9am – 6pm

Saturday | 9 am – 6pm

How much are tickets for the Show?

Super Saver Ticket (1 December - 18 February)

£20 – Adult (inc. 2 free children)

£6 – Additional Child

Advance Ticket (19 February - 25 May)

£22 – Adult (inc. 2 free children)

£6 – Additional Child

Gate Ticket (26 May – 4 June)

£25 – Adult

£6 – Additional Child

£23 – Senior Ticket

How can I book tickets?

Can I purchase tickets on the day?

Tickets can be purchased on the day, however there are some great savings to be made when booking in advance. Super Saver Tickets & Advance Saver Tickets also benefit from FREE admission for up to two children (aged 5 – 15 years)

What age range is a child?

Children are aged between 5 – 15 years.

My child is under 5 years old – do I have to pay for them?

Children under the age of five are FREE

Can I camp at the Show?

Camping is available to purchase on our website (bathandwest.com/tickets).

Pitches are £20 per night for a Grass, Non-Electric Pitch.

You will also need to purchase a ticket to gain access to the Show.

What does Show Membership include?

Show Membership offers guaranteed entry to all 3 days of the Royal Bath & West Show. Benefits of a Show Membership include:

- 1 x Entry badge for all 3 days of the Royal Bath & West Show
- 1 x Guest Badge for the Royal Bath & West Show (does not admit to the Show) allowing your guest access to the Butcombe Bar
- 1 x Free Show Programme Voucher
- Access to Lunch & tea facilities in the Butcombe Bar in the Wessex Pavilion at the Royal Bath & West Show
- Forward Area Parking at the Royal Bath & West Show

The cost of Show Membership is £50 for 2022

What is your disabled ticketing policy for 2022?

We are pleased to operate a scheme to provide one free entry ticket for a Carer/PA of a qualified disabled visitor to enable them to access the Show. Full details can be found on our website -

Can I hire a mobility scooter at the Show?

Yes, mobility scooters are available to hire. We would recommend you book in advance to avoid disappointment. They are available for collection from the Yellow Gate Entrance. Details are available on our website - www.bathandwest.com/royal-bath-and-west-show/visitors/tickets

Where is the disabled parking located at the Show?

The disabled parking is located at the front of our Yellow Car Park. Please follow the AA Road Signs. Don't forget to present your blue badge on arrival and one of the Car Parking Stewards will direct you to the disabled parking area.

How much is parking?

Parking is FREE

Do you have baby changing facilities?

Yes, we have baby changing facilities located in each toilet block. We also have baby changing facilities in the outdoor RED Accessible Toilet Block (Orchard) and in the Showering Pavilion Accessible Toilet Block.

Can I fly my drone at your event?

Due to the number of people and livestock at our event the flying of drones from or over the Royal Bath & West Show is strictly prohibited.

Will there be a Family Trail this year?

This year we will be running a Jubilee themed Family Trail. Similar to our usual Family Trail, you will be able to follow the instructions and make your way to the relevant Family Trail Stops. Don't forget to fill in the form and pop your Family Trail in the post box as you leave the Show to be entered into a prize draw! The Family Trail can be collected on arrival from the entrance gates

Can I bring my dog to the Show?

Yes, dogs are welcome to come along to the Show, but we do kindly ask that they are always kept on a lead. There are a handful of areas where dogs are not permitted. These areas include: The Main Lawn, the Food & Drink Marquee, the Horticulture Tent, the Poultry Tent & within any Livestock Buildings / Marquees.
