Correctness of Details (Reg 18)	It is the Exhibitors' or Competitors' responsibility to ensure that all the information provided is correct.

Equine Flu (Reg 48)

All equines attending the Bath & West Equine Showing Show 2021 must have been vaccinated for Equine Influenza.

Equines may attend having received the primary course, and prior to the first booster, but not within 7 days of receiving a vaccine dose. The primary course is 1st vaccination and then 2nd vaccination 21 - 92 days later. This should be followed by the first booster (150 - 215 days) and all subsequent boosters.

All Equines must have been vaccinated within the 6 months prior to the Show.

Foals - In-foal mares that have already had vaccinations of primary Equine Influenza course should be vaccinated 4-6 weeks before the foal is due to be born. Foals should be vaccinated for Equine Influenza at 6 months to commence their primary course.

Numbers and Passes

Exhibitors will be able to download a template of their number. This will act as entry into the event. A maximum of 3 people may attend the show per horse, this includes the rider.

As this event is being held behind closed doors there will be no option to purchase additional tickets. Please print off your number and display clearly in the front of your vehicle as these will be checked upon entry into the event.

Please do not give this number to anyone else as the number will only be allowed entry to the event once.

If you are staying overnight there will be no camping allowed on the showground in tents or caravans and no additional passes issued for this.

There will be a downloadable template for Track & Trace purposes available nearer the time which should be filled out correctly and handed into the gate on arrival. Alternatively there will be a QR code available on the day.

The Winning Horse or Pony from each of the qualifying sections on Friday will be entitled to a free stable on the Showground if required on Friday night.

HC1 The following class is a qualifier for the Supreme In-Hand Championship, NEC, Birmingham, 6th-10th October 2021

The objective of the competition is to find the supreme light horse or pony in-hand champion of the year, irrespective of breed or type (excluding heavy horses). The Champion horse or pony from the following classes will be eligible to compete, provided it has not already won a qualifying round in 2021.

Hunter Breeding, Hack Breeding, Riding Horse Breeding, Sport Horse Breeding, Irish Draught Breeding, Riding Pony Breeding, Coloured Horse and Pony Breeding, Conemara, Dales & Fell, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Highland, New Forest, Shetland (Miniature), Shetland (Standard), Welsh Mountain Pony (Section A), Welsh Pony (Section B), Welsh Pony (Cob Type) (Section C), Welsh Cob (Section D) and Part Bred Welsh.

If the Champion has already qualified or is ineligible, then the Reserve Champion of that section may come forward, provided it has not already qualified and is eligible. If both Champion and Reserve Champion have already qualified or are ineligible, then the section will not be represented in this qualifying round. Foal champions are not eligible.

In the event of a horse/pony having been awarded more than one section Championship at this show, that horse/pony will represent both/all sections and the qualification will not pass down to the Reserve in the 2nd and subsequent sections.

There will be no direct entry in the Supreme In-hand Championship Qualified, all animals must be a section champion or reserve champion (as applicable)

NPS/KILMANNAN STUD M&M IN HAND SILVER MEDAL ROSETTE

A Silver Medal Rosette is offered by the National Pony Society for the best registered pony owned by an NPS Qualifying or Life member in the M&M In Hand sections. The Sponsor's Rosette is also awarded to the pony receiving the qualification.

To be judged under the rules of the NPS. NPS silver medal rosettes are only awarded when the owner of the champion pony is a Qualifying or Life Member of the NPS. A valid membership card must be in the rider's/handler's possession on entering the ring and be produced immediately on request by either the judge or the steward. If the Owner of the Champion Pony is not a Member, or the owner's membership card is not immediately produced the rosette may be awarded to the Reserve Champion provided they have the required membership card. If the Champion has previously qualified it is still entitled to the Silver Medal Rosette but the Qualification Card goes to the Reserve Champion Pony, provided the Owner of that pony is a Member of the NPS. Class H3 HUNTER FILLY, COLT OR GELDING

Three years old, foaled in 2018.

Class H4 SMALL & LIGHTWEIGHT HUNTER BROOD MARE

Small hunter mares to exceed 148cms but not exceeding 158cms with foal at foot or a relevant certificate of pregnancy which may be inspected at the show.

Class H5 HUNTER FOAL

Produce of mare shown in class H4.

Class H6 MIDDLEWEIGHT & HEAVYWEIGHT HUNTER BROOD MARE

Exceeding 158cms, with foal at foot or a relevant certificate of pregnancy which may be inspected at the show.

Class H7 HUNTER FOAL

Produce of mare shown in class H6.

HC3 For the Champion Hunter Breeding Brood mare

Brood mares only are eligible. Royal Bath & West Champion and Reserve Champion rosette.

HC4 For the Champion Hunter Breeding Youngstock

1st and 2nd prize winners in classes H1, H2, H3, H5 and H7. Royal Bath & West Champion and Reserve Champion rosette.

HS1 Brood Mare Premium Awards

SHB(GB) - One offered in the Small & Lightweight Hunter Brood Mare class and one in the Middleweight & Heavyweight Hunter Brood Mare class. The premiums will only be awarded if there are a minimum of three mares forward per class. It will take the form of a Service Voucher, the value of which is to be determined from time to time by SHB(GB), awarded at the Judge's discretion to their selection from the monetary prize winners, to be used towards the cost of covering the mare by any SHB(GB) Graded Stallion or Life Approved Premium Stallion that is properly registered for the year of covering. This Service Voucher may be used in either of the two years following the year of award. The owner must be, or become, a fully paid up member of SHB(GB) in order to be eligible for the award. No mare shall take more than one award per year.

NOTE: Grade I and II mares are eligible to be transferred into the SHB(GB) Stud Book.

Day Ticket = £36 entitles competitors to compete at a maximum of 2 shows in the year – (£36 per day ticket - it covers owner and rider membership together with horse registration for that show). If the class is a qualifying class for RIHS, in order for the qualification to be valid, application for full owner/rider membership and horse registration must be received in the SHB(GB) office within 14 days.

Royal International Horse Show

Classes H9 to H13 are qualifying classes and only horses registered on the Show Hunter Register are eligible to enter. Registration numbers must be quoted on the entry form and owners and riders must be members of the Sport Horse Breeding (GB). These classes will attract a £10.00 RIHS Levy with each entry. In Classes H9 to H13 the two highest placed in each class will qualify but no horse lower than second will qualify.

The Polly Coles 4 & 5 Year Old Ridden Hunter Championship

The top three 4 or 5 year olds in any SHB(GB) Novice Ridden Hunter Class H8, held at shows prior to the 2021 Hunter Show will qualify. Qualification will not pass down the line. At the final to be held at the SHB(GB) National Hunter Supreme Championship Show the highest placed 4 & 5 year olds will each receive £500. At the Championship 4 & 5 year olds will be judged separately.

Four years old or over, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 158cms.

In the lightweight section, the two highest placed Small and the two highest placed Lightweights will qualify; and in the heavyweight section the two highest placed Middleweights and the two highest placed Heavyweights will qualify.

Four years old or over, capable of carrying up to 79.5kgs (12 stone 7lbs). Small hunters to be included in this category. To be ridden and owned by an amateur. (RIHS Qualifier)

Class H15 AMATEUR HEAVYWEIGHT HUNTER MARE OR GELDING

Four years old or over, capable of carrying over 79.5kgs (12 stone 7lbs). Middleweight hunters to be included in this category. To be ridden and owned by an amateur. (RIHS Qualifier)

HC6 For the Champion Amateur Hunter

Royal Bath & West Champion and Reserve Champion rosette.

Day Ticket = £36 entitles competitors to compete at a maximum of 2 shows in the year - (£36 per day ticket - it covers owner and rider membership together with horse registration for that show). If the class is a qualifying class for RIHS, in order for the qualification to be valid, application for full owner/rider membership and horse registration must be received in the SHB(GB) office within 14 days.

Any horse which has qualified as a Grade A Show Jumper or Advanced Event Horse as at 1 January in the current year is not eligible to compete in Working Hunter classes. Working Hunters will not jump in catalogue order.

Royal International Horse Show

Class H16 is a qualifying class and only horses registered on the Show Hunter Register are eligible to enter. Registration numbers must be quoted on the entry form and owners and riders must be members of the Sport Horse Breeding (GB). This classes will attract a £10.00 RIHS Levy with each entry. The three highest placed horses will qualify to enter at the Royal International Horse Show. No horse lower than third will qualify.

Class H16 OPEN WORKING HUNTER, MARE, GELDING OR STALLION

(Competing stallions must have a red, white and blue ribbon in their tails). Four years old or over, exceeding 148cms. Fences will not exceed 1.14m (3ft 9inch). (RIHS qualifier).

The maximum total points available is 100, made up of: Jumping points = Max 40 points,

Style & Presence whilst Jumping = Max 20 points,

Ride/Manners = Max 20 points,

Conformation = Max 20.

Class H17 NOVICE WORKING HUNTER, MARE, GELDING OR STALLION

(Competing stallions must have a red, white and blue ribbon displayed in their tail). Four years old or over. Not to have won a total of £100 excluding Championship prize money, (or equivalent values) in prize money in any SHB(GB) affiliated Working Hunter Class, or more than 5 BE points or 200 BS points, at home or equivalent abroad before 1 January in the relevant year. Fences in this class to have a minimum height of 0.85m (2ft 9inch) and a maximum height of 1m (3ft 3inch).

Class H18 AMATUER WORKING HUNTER

Mare or gelding, four years old or over, exceeding 148cms. To be ridden by an amateur as defined under 2021 SHB(GB) rules. Fences will not exceed 1.07m (3ft 6inch). All entries must be registered with SHB(GB).

HC7 For the Champion Working Hunter

Royal Bath & West Champion and Reserve Champion Rosette.

SIDE SADDLE

Judges: Mrs Jinks Bryer

Judging on: Friday

Run under SSA Rules defined in the current member's Handbook. Open to SSA Members and Non-Members.

Competitors must wear a hat to current Safety Standard or above (see Regulations).

Class H19 OPEN EQUITATION

Horses or ponies four years old or over. Confirmation and manners will be taken into consideration; horses/ponies will not be stripped. Members carrying their current Championship Points Cards are eligible for SSA rosettes to 3rd Adult and 3rd Junior places and SSA Championship Points.

Southernden Farm offers a rosette to the highest placed Member aged under 14 on 1 January of the current year.

A rosette in memory of The Late Mr R Philpot is offered to the Adult Member and Manor Grange Stud Show Centre to the Junior Member, judged to be the best turned out.

Class H20 BEST HORSE OR PONY RIDDEN SIDE SADDLE

Open to horses or ponies four years old or over. Confirmation and manners will be taken into consideration; horses will not be stripped. A Special rosette will be awarded to the highest placed Adult and Junior Members of the SSA carrying their current Championship Points Cards. Competitors must wear a hat to current Safety Standard or above.

The Highest placed coloured exhibit ridden by a competitor aged 16rs or over (who has not already qualified) receives a Special Rosette and qualifies for the Side Saddle Final at the CHAPS Championship Show. Open to any type of exhibit. Riders/Owners need not be a member or their exhibit registered with CHAPS at the time of qualification, but in order to compete at the Championships, the Rider/Owner must be a showing member and their horse/pony registered with CHAPS before entering the final. Lead Rein competitors are eligible for this class. Leaders must be correctly dressed.

Class H21 CONCOURS D'ELEGANCE

Open to horses or ponies four years old or over. The sole criteria is the elegance of the picture presented by horse/pony and rider. Attention may be paid to the rider's personal appaerance but a detailed inspection of rider or tack will not be required. Fancy dress or period costume is not permitted.

Competitors will be required to walk, trot and canter. No individual show is required, but the Judge may ask small groups of 3 or 4 riders to give short displays.

A special rosette will be awarded to the highest placed Adult and Junior Members, carrying their current Championship Points Card. Competitors must wear a hate to current Safety Standard or above.

HACK AND RIDING HORSE BREEDING

Judging on: Friday

Held under the rules of the British Show Horse Association. Owners, Handlers and Horses must be registered or have temporary membership with a Day Ticket. In-Hand Horses registered with the Association must be Owned by current BSHA Members.

DAY TICKETS: Non-Members may purchase up to a maximum of 2 Day Tickets per Exhibitor, per Horse, per Rider, per season. A Day Ticket will allow entry into Amateur, Home Produced, In-Hand, Novice, Working, Young Rider and Open affiliated classes only, BUT WILL NOT ALLOW entry into RIHS or HOYS qualifying classes. Horses registered on a Day Ticket do not require a JMB height certificate. Competitors can apply for a Day Ticket by downloading an application form, or apply online on the BSHA website.

Horse of the Year Show

This Show is a Horse of the Year Show Supreme In-Hand Championship 2021 Qualifier. Foal Champions are not eligible.

BSHA Supreme In-Hand Breeding Championships

This is a qualifier for the BSHA Polly Coles Supreme In-Hand Breeding Championship to be held at the BSHA National Championships in September 2021, with £1000 to the winner. Champion and Reserve to qualify. THE BSHA offer a qualified rosette to the Champion and Reserve.

The BSHA offers an Owner/Breeder rosette in each In-Hand Breeding class with the exception of the Foal classes, these have been kindly sponsored by the Kellythorpe Stud.

NPS Supreme Championships

This Show is a qualifier for the NPS/Case Sheet Metal Fabrication Ottergayle Hack & Riding Horse In Hand Supreme Championship. The owner does not have to be an NPS member for the horse to enter this competition, to qualify or to enter the final. The highest placed horse in each class will qualify for the final. Qualification may pass down to third place if the first and second horses are already qualified. Foals are excluded from qualifying.

Class H22 HACK FILLY, COLT OR GELDING

Ridden competitors must wear a safety/kit mark hard hat with chinstrap.

Class H26 THE ROR RETRAINED RACEHORSE CHALLENGE 2021

Mare or gelding 4yrs old or over and of any height. Riders must be 15 years or over on the 1st January of the calendar year holding the classes. Horses to be ridden in any suitable bridle and should be plaited. All entries must be registered with RoR and HAVE raced in GB. Racing injuries and blemishes ARE IGNORED in this series The first three go forward to the final at the RoR National Championships, Aintree in August 2021

The judge will NOT ride. Horses may be stripped for conformation at the discretion of the judge.

Competitors must wear a safety/kite mark hard hat with a chinstrap. All those entering horses and/or participating in the show agree to be bound by the Retraining of Racehorses Rules and Regulations from time to time in force'

The class to be judged 50% jumping, 20% Style while jumping and performance and 30% awarded for show, manners and suitability to be retrained.

PHASE 1

Jumping to be judged:

8 rustic jumps 3 foot (90cm) to 3 foot 3 inches (1 metre) with a maximum spread of 95 centimeters)

The following points to be deducted at the end of each jumping round:

10 points to be deducted for a knock down.

15 points to be deducted for a refusal.

20 points for second refusal.

Elimination for third refusal or fall or Error of Course.

PHASE 2

Class returns without boots and judged for an individual show/conformation. Only one exhibit may qualify per class. Royal International Horse Show

Classes H50 to H52 are qualifiers for The Royal International Horse Show and will attract a £10.00 RIHS levy with each entry. The first prize winner will qualify to compete at the final. If already qualified the second will qualify, if the first and second are already qualified then the third will go forward.

Horses competing at the RIHS and qualifying shows in Hunter sections of The Sport Horse Breeding of Great Britain at their Affiliated Shows cannot compete in Hack, Cobs and Riding Horse classes at the same show, on the same day and vice versa. This does not apply to SHB (GB) Ridden Sport Horse classes.

BSHA National Championship Show

The 1st or highest placed prize winners in each Open Affiliated class will qualify to compete in the BSHA Classic of the Year Final. The Finals will be held at the BSHA Hunter & National Championship Shows in September 2021.

The BSHA offer a Novice, Young Rider and Amateur rosette in each Open class and a Champion rosette for each section (with the exception of Open Working Show Horse, Ladies Show Horse & HOYS Hunter classes).

North of England

Class H52 is a qualifier for The 'Mrs Candy' Supreme Ridden Show Horse Championship the final will be held at the North of England Summer Show on 26 June 2021. If the winner has already qualified, then the second prize winner will go forward. Only the first and second prize winners may qualify.

Class H53 is a qualifier for The 'Colosso Family' Supreme Amateur Ridden Show Horse Championship the final will be held at the North of England Summer Show on 26 June 2021. Only the first and second prize winners will qualify.

Class H49 NOVICE COB/MAXI COB, MARE OR GELDING

Four years old or over, exceeding 148cms. . A Novice is a Cob that has not won a first prize of £35 or more, or more than a total of £250 (including Championship Prize Money) in any showing classes excluding Working Show Horse, Best Trained, Pairs, Side Saddle or In-Hand classes that were Affiliated to the Association, at home or abroad, prior to 1 January in the current year. Winnings as a four year old are exempt, unless thar four year old has won an Open ridden class with a prize of £35 or more. If the category has changed from a Hack to a Riding Horse or vice versa, it may not revert back to a Novice. Snaffle bridles may be worn for Novice classes. Novice animals must be registered with the Association or exhibitors must have purchased a 'Day Ticket' in order to compete in Novice classes. Animals which have been placed first at either the Royal International Horse Show or Horse of the Year Show in any ridden class, BSHA or otherwise, are ineligible to compete in Novice Hack, Cob, Maxi Cob or Riding Horse classes.

Class H50 LIGHTWEIGHT RIDING COB, MARE OR GELDING

Four years old or over, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 155cms, capable of carrying up to 14 stone. (RIHS qualifier)

Class H51 HEAVYWEIGHT RIDING COB, MARE OR GELDING

Four years old or over, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 155cms, capable of carrying more than 14 stone. (RIHS qualifier)

Class H52 MAXI COB, MARE OR GELDING

Four years old or over, exceeding 155cms. To be judged as a Cobs. Judges must pay particular attention to type (i.e. short legged animals of COB type). To be shown hogged. (RIHS qualifier). WINNERS OF THESE CLASSES (MAXI) ARE NOT ELIGIBLE FOR OPEN COB CHAMPIONSHIPS. (If all cob classes are in the championship then the maxi can go in, ie Novice, Amateur cob classes)

Any horse which is a Grade B Showjumper, Intermediate Eventer, or above, as at 1 January of the current year, is not eligible to compete in any Working Show Horse class. A rider may ride up to two horses in the jumping phase, but must then select one horse to take through to the ride and conformation phases (if required). No change of rider is allowed.
