<b>Departure of Animals</b>		Animals may be loaded: From 4:00pm Saturday
<b>Stock Gate</b>		Will be closed between 8:30am and 7:00pm each day.
<b>Exhibitor Camping</b>		Caravans, motorhomes, tents, trailers etc used by Stock Exhibitors staying on site during the Show, must be located in the Stock Exhibitors' Camping Park for Emergency Services reasons.  No electricity is provided but the use of silent diesel generators is permitted from 9:00am to 5:00pm.
<b>Stalling &amp; Penning</b>		
<b>Sheep</b>		A maximum of 5 pens (to include kit pen) per exhibitor per breed.  A fee is no chargeable per pen (£7.50) and pens must be booked and paid for when making entries.  Pens booked above this number will not be refunded.  If an exhibitor wishes additional pens, please notify the office and if, after entries close additional pens are available, they will be allocated as necessary.

Smoking (Reg 10)	<b>Smoking (including E-cigarettes) is not allowed in any of the livestock buildings, sheep lines, dairy, parlour or any indoor areas. Owners of animals being exhibited will be held responsible for the behaviour of their stockpersons and for the consequences of any misconduct.</b>
Competence of Exhibitors (Reg 21)	All Exhibitors must have the physical ability and experience and be competent to handle animals in their charge.
Removal of Animals (Reg 42)	No animal shall be removed from its place in the show except at the times stated in the schedule.
Veterinary Examinations (Reg 45)	The decision of the Veterinary Officer shall be final and conclusive. Exhibitors shall be liable to pay for drugs administered by the Veterinary Officers.
Sheep	<b>Tail Docking</b> – enough of the tail retained to cover the vulva (female) or anus (male). Animals will be inspected either upon arrival or in the lines and sheep failing to comply will not be eligible. (Reg 80) <b>Orf</b> – animals found to be affected will be disqualified from competition and removed from the show. (Reg 50) <b>Scab</b> - it is recommended that sheep are treated for Scab a fortnight before the Show. (Reg 51)
