Reluctantly, we have taken the decision to postpone this year's Royal Bath & West Show until the summer, 31st July – 2nd August. Following the Government's guidance, it is clear that COVID-19 will still be very active within our communities during May and June so we feel it is the most responsible action to reschedule to protect our visitors, traders and exhibitors from the spread of the virus.

We appreciate that there is a great deal of public concern surrounding the outbreak of Coronavirus and so we have compiled a list of Frequently Asked Questions below to answer any concerns you might have:

TICKETS

Q – Now that the Royal Bath & West Show has been postponed, will I be issued a refund for my ticket?

A - Good news, your ticket will be valid for the rearranged show dates, 31st July – 2nd August, and you do not need to do anything.

Q - I can't make the new date, can I get a refund on my ticket?

A - Yes, there will be the option to get the value of your tickets refunded. Our ticket agency will have details about how to claim that. Alternatively, you may roll your ticket over to next year's event.

Q – Where can I find up to date information about events at the Showground?

A – We will publish any changes to our events line-up on our website and across our social media channels.

Q – When is the Royal Bath & West Show?

A – This year's event will now take place between 31st July – 2nd August.

Q - Will the programme and exhibitors be the same for the postponed show?

A – Our aim is to keep the programme and exhibitors as close to the current plan as possible. We will be liaising with all our exhibitors and competitors and hope that they are able to make the rearranged date.
